- **1. Discussion: The Book**


As luck would have it I am still at the beginning of Chapter 4. For the moment it will be the First Generation of the Pencombe family as known to me and located at North Molton in 1486. Why has the unknown Pyncombe come to North Molton with John Ia Zouch, 7th Baron Zouche, 8th Baron St Maur? The Baron was attainted for supporting Richard III at the Battle of Bosworth Field in 1483 and sent to North Molton as a punishment. Originally I thought that the unknown Pyncombe was perhaps an attendant of the Baron but I suspect he was more like a guard ensuring that the Barton remained at North Molton until Henry VII decided he could leave that particular manor where he was basically "jailed" until something else was decided. For that service, presumably the unknown Pyncombe received land at North Molton. I do have some old documents that I need to transcribe out of the latin at some point and I will be doing that as I write this book.

I use several documents to look at this family in the late 1400s and early 1500s. The first is the Visitation of Devon 1620 with additions which takes this family at North Molton back to Unknown Pyncombe and his three listed sons – two named John and one named Thomas. The second is the original version of that Visitation which lists Unknown Pyncombe and three sons –



Thomas, John and unknown. The other document that I use is the 1524-27 Devon Lay Subsidies. I reproduce the original Visitation of Devon 1620 from a copy of the book which Sir Henry St George et al. created as the Visitations of Devon 1620 (available on Internet Archive).

This appears on pages 230 and 231 of the original Visitations of Devon 1620 (Internet Archive - The visitation of the county of Devon in the year 1620 by Saint-George, Henry, Sir, 1581-1644; Lennard, Samson, d. 1633; Camden, William, 1551-1623; Colby, Frederic Thomas, 1827-1899, ed; College of Arms (Great Britain) Publication date 1872 Publisher London (Book from the collections of Harvard University, USA)), there are advantages to using the updated Visitations of Devon 1620 and I will refer to it. But this one names the children in a likely correct fashion of the first Pyncombe at North Molton who arrived with Lord la Zouch about the beginning of Henry VII as stated in the visitation.

The original layout:





The Subsidy Rolls from 1524-1527 give a superb look at the population of Devon in this time frame. The Type refers to G (goods) or W (wages) and the amount is in the legal currency of the time. Noting the spellings below Pencombe is the most frequent and shared by three members of the family at North Molton. The forename of the first member of the family at North Molton was not given but there is a John Pencombe with a value of G(Goods) at 5 and living next to him or with him is a Thomas Pencombe and he is paid W (wages) and one could conceivably see him as the son of John. Living at South Molton Borough is a John Penceme and I believe he is the John Pyncombe on the 1620 Visitation of Devon. He is married and one can assume he has married an heiress as he is worth 10 G(Goods). In South Molton there is also a Chris Pyncombe and this John Pyncombe at South Molton is known to have two sons John and Christopher. The third Pencombe at North Molton is William and I assume he is the unknown son of John Pencombe and he has the value of 2 G(Goods) so he is older than Thomas. That perhaps gives us the order of these children mentioned on the Visitation of John, William and Thomas. Thus yielding the second generation of this family at North Molton.

I have also included a different spelling that sort of resembles Pencombe and it is Pyncowe. The logic in doing so even though I did discover this is a valid surname in Devon, was locating a Thomas and Elinor Pyncowe at East Buckland where Thomas Pencombe later lives. There are a couple of possibilities; firstly, this could be the maternal uncle of Thomas and brother in law of John Pencombe or it could be a brother of John Pencombe of North Molton. These two men could have been part of the group appointed to escort John Lord la Zouch to North Molton. The misspelling is perhaps accounted for because of the other family with this spelling being in the Braunton Hundred (the distance apart though between East Buckland and Ilfracombe is around 30 kilometres). It could still be a coincidence but history demands that we look at all possibilities before forming any sort of conclusive thought.





That does give me a beginning tree for this family that fits with available data. The Lay Subsidy is the most powerful data as it was recorded in the different areas and not the product of a survey which is basically what a Visitation is.

I will also provide a copy of the Visitation of Devon 1620 with additions:





This one simply provides more information and my putting it in this newsletter should not be taken to mean that I agree with every line of the document. It is an interesting document though and does capture quite a bit of information that I know to be accurate.

2. DNA and its value in the study

When this study was created by Galen Pinkham and Dr Richard Pinkham the two surnames were chosen – Pincombe and Pinkham. Both surnames are used within the Pincombe family that descended from the North Molton Pencombe family. Given the knowledge that I have accumulated on yDNA I will continue reviewing the results of the yDNA tests that have been done within the project. I may also actively try to recruit more testers. I will continue looking at the latest finds in terms of archaeological studies regarding particularly ancient British yDNA but also more and more people are testing who live on the European Continent in the Flanders area so that too is something I will continue observing. More comments once I have thought through all of this and done research on what has been learned about the various haplogroups.

3. Landkey Parish Records

These burial records are transcribed from the fiche of the original Parish Records for Landkey, Devon. I have changed the orientation of the newsletter to make it easier to publish the transcriptions for Landkey directly from my Excel file. I only purchased the Parish Records into the early to mid 1700s so these records do not extend past that date. This concludes the burial records of Landkey that I have transcribed thus far.
